Harbour Map



Early Arrivals:

Boats must stay outside of the harbor if coming before June 29 and not attending to the Kieler Woche Euro-Cup. Options are the beach or the near harbour Strande.

The Olympic Centre Schilksee will be open from the 29 of June, for the berthing area see the harbor map.

Parking:

Parking in the harbour is permitted only for berth holders of the olympic harbor with their special parking permit. Everyone else is strictly prohibited from parking in the harbour. The harbour is open for loading and unloading boats and RIBs. Please move your cars and road trailers to the various free parking areas shown on the harbour map once you have finished.

Parking of Rib and 29er Road Trailers:

The trailers must be placed within the marked area on the harbor map. "Trailer"

Berthing fees before Worlds (Monday to Wednesday before the event)

The Olympia Hafen Schilksee is managed by the Sporthafen GmbH. Therefore, berth fees must be paid from Monday, June 29, to Wednesday, July 1. Earlier arrival is not possible due to Kieler Woche.

Participants of 29er Euro-Cup have the option to pay the fee for three days during check-in. All 29ers arriving after June 28 must pay the berth fees directly to the harbor masters. The harbor masters can be contacted at: schilksee@sporthafen-kiel.de. From July 2 onwards, the berth fees are included in the entry fee.

Camping

The camping site is next to the race village and in walking distance to the harbor. Due to huge capacities a reservation is neither possible nor necessary. Please find the prices for camping at [FAQ - Sailing - Kieler Woche](#)

Sanitary facilities are on the camping site for free. Next to the camping site are the bathrooms from the harbor area. Shower coins for the showers in the harbor area are available at the office of the harbor master or in the race office.

Support Boats:

If you are bringing a RIB as a coach or support boat during the event, please ensure you registered it on the event website prior to arrival and you will also have to register on site Regatta office when you arrive.

The registration time is stated in the Notice of Race.

Launching & berthing for ribs:

Launching ramps are in the center of the harbor, see harbor map.

Berthing for coach ribs are permitted in the designated areas "Coach", see harbor map.

Petrol Station:

The nearest petrol station is located in the northern harbor of Strande, about one mile away.

Dinghy Park:

29er must remain in the designated areas during the event. See harbor map.

Race Office:

The Race Office is located at the Olympic Sailing Center in the middle of the harbor, see harbor map.

Inside of the Race Office is the registration, the jury and the technical committee.

Registration:

After registering via the International 29er Class website, the data will be imported into Manage2Sail.

For the on-site check-in, we require the following document to be completed and signed by the skipper. If the skipper is a minor (under 18 years of age), the parents or legal guardians must additionally sign the [Limitation of Liability form](#).

Tally-RFID System:

An RFID sign-in & sign-out system will be used during the 29er World Championship. Each boat will receive an RFID wristband during the on-site check-in.

When leaving the harbor to go on the water, participants must check in at the designated terminals, and upon returning, they must check out again. Further information will be provided in the Sailing Instructions. You can find the terminals on the harbor map.

Racing Areas:

Racing areas for the 29er World Championship are Alpha/Bravo/Charlie, check SI.

Sustainability:

To help protect the environment we ask that sailors use reusable bottles throughout the event. Please remember to bring reusable bottles for your team.

Water bottle refill points are located in the harbor, see harbor map.

Rubbish bins are all around the harbor and the event area.

Facilities:

Toilets, Showers and changing rooms you will find on the harbor map.

Regatta meals:

There will be snacks after every racing day in the competitor's lounge. On Monday, the 6th July, there will be a Mid-Week dinner for all competitors and coaches.

- Informal meeting for parents with the Class, Midweek dinner & Pub Quiz

An equipment manufacturer will be present on the event site to provide repairs, charter services, and spare parts.
