WHAT TO EXPECT

Parking

- All vehicles can be parked in the Parking Samuel Bassaget (218 Rue Samuel Bassaget, 34130 Mauguio, France - Latitude : 43.542033 | Longitude : 3.971011) on the west side of the harbour.

Please be aware of two different routes for driving with trailers – high or low as depicted in the map below.

Parking of Rib and 29er Road Trailers

- If you arrive before April 30th, trailer storage will be in the East trailer parking lot. Send a message to the coach group 30 minutes before arriving to check if the parking lot is open. Trailers for those arriving from April 30th onwards will be stored in the Bassaget parking lot.

Support Boats & RIB Launching

If you are bringing a RIB as a coach or support boat during the event, please ensure you registered it on the event website prior to arrival and you will also have to register on site Regatta office when you arrive.

Launching of RIBs is at:

There are 3 different launching ramps

- Club House (right bank)
- Carré Sports (left bank)
- Rowing Club

Attention ! The club House slipway will be closed for launching Zodiac boats during the following periods:

- March 28th from 1:30 PM to 5:30 PM
- March 31st from 9:30 AM to 10:30 AM and from 3:00 PM to 3:30 PM
- April 1st from 1:30 PM to 5:30 PM

If you arrive before March, 30th, please before launching, ask the staff by the WhatsApp Canal which one is best to use depending on the day of arrival and the different needs.

RIBs Retrieval – Sunday Departure

All slipways indicated on the event map will be available throughout the event to facilitate launching and recovery.

On Sunday, the harbour master's office will provide a high-pressure washer with desalinated water, allowing coaches to rinse their boats. Please contact the organizing team if you are interested.

To leave the regatta more efficiently on Sunday, you can ask to the Dry Marina of Pérols (see map for location) for a mechanical "Sortie d'eau". Same as last year, they can assist you at reasonable cost of 25€ (Just say that you're an EuroCup Coach from the regatta)

Petrol Station

The nearest petrol station for refueling ribs is inside the harbour, by the harbour office, see the **plan**.

Rib Parking

Reserved rib moorings will be on both sides of the harbour, either by the club house or left bank boat park.

New for 2026 – Event Area Extended Across Both Sides!!!

This year, the event area is extended across both sides of the harbour, offering more space, comfort, and smoother operations. The entire fore-harbour will be used to better distribute boats and teams, including access to a second slipway at “Carré Sports” on the Left Bank to increase launching capacity.

The main event life will still be centered on the Right Bank, in front of the clubhouse, where all key services and activities will take place.

Sailors launching from the Left Bank will keep their boats stored on the Left Bank throughout the event.

Coaches may organize transfers between both sides using the dedicated pontoons available on each bank. A support boat will be on standby during the event to assist with operations and respond to any urgent situations if needed.

Dinghy Park

Dinghies will be stored in designated areas within the venue. Each team will be assigned a specific zone upon arrival.

Sailors are requested to check in with the Boat Park Team to receive their allocation and any related instructions.

Please ensure that boats are parked correctly within the assigned area to optimize space and maintain safe circulation for all participants.

There will be surveillance in the boat park during the night.

29er Launching

On the slipways, **excluding the rowing club slipway.**

Registration

At your arrival, please proceed to the Registration Office inside the Clubhouse to complete and confirm your registration.

You will receive your welcome pack, lunch tickets (if pre-ordered), your Sailors' Dinner ticket (if pre-ordered), as well as a sticker for your boat and your trolley.

Previous step :

- 1 - Registration on the website (<https://www.eurocup-29er-carnon.com/registrations/>)
- 2 - Payment on HelloAsso (link at the end of the registration form, link below) ,
- 3 - Documents required (uploaded or deposit at registration office):
 - International 29er's class membership for all sailors;
 - French 29er's class membership for French sailors;
 - For FFVoile sailors, a valid FFVoile Club licence with "Competition" mention or FFVoile Club License mentioning "Pratiquant" or "Adhésion" accompanied with:
 - for minors, a testimonial of completion of a questionnaire related to the health condition of the minor competitor
 - for adults, a medical certificate dated less than one year, mentioning the absence of any medical objection to participate in sailing competition.
 - For each competitor without a FFVoile Club licence, whether foreign or French national living abroad:
 - a supporting document to justify membership to a World Sailing Member national authority.
 - a supporting document to justify a valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of 2 million Euros.
 - for minors, a testimonial of completion of a questionnaire related to the health condition of the minor competitor or, for adults, a medical certificate dated less than one year, mentioning the absence of any medical objection to participate in sailing competition (written in French or English).
 - A parental authorization for any minor competitor.

Tally System

All sailors must use the sign-in / sign-out system before launching and after returning ashore. A reminder will be given during the briefing.

Race Courses

The fleet will be split into 2 to 4 fleets depending on the number of registered boats.

Up to 90 boats, there will be 2 fleets.

Between 91 and 135 boats, there will be 3 fleets.

Between 136 and 180 boats, there will be 4 fleets.

Fleets' locations will be given during the daily skippers' briefing.

Sustainability

To help protect the environment we ask that sailors use reusable bottles throughout the event. Please remember to bring reusable bottles for your team.

- Water bottle refill points are located in front of the Club House, and also on the Left side Area.
- Rubbish bins are available everywhere on the event site.
- All sailors entered in the regatta MUST take part in a Clean Walk.

To respect the race schedule, each team can choose when to carry out their action. The Clean Walk must be completed on Saturday or Sunday only.

How to proceed:

- Meet the Green Team (also referred to as Trash Managers), identifiable by their green hats
- Sign in and collect waste collection equipment
- Go to the designated area and do your best to leave it as clean as possible
- Return to the Green Team for a photo

Important for sailors:

Prizes will be awarded for the most unusual item collected, the largest quantity of waste, and the funniest photo (feel free to bring accessories to increase your chances).

We kindly ask that these are not used on site and especially not inside the building.


