3 RULES

3.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing ISAF 2013-2016 and those of the 29er class.

3.2 Swiss federal law for inland navigation with amendments will apply.



4 ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

- 4.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the International 29er Class.
- 4.2 Eligible boats may enter through www.29er-yclo.ch
- 4.3 **Parent/Guardian Declarations:** All helms and crews under 18 years of age during the event shall submit a signed Parent/Guardian Declarations which can be downloaded from the event site.
- 4.4 Sailors must be members of the Int. 29er Class. For registration or renewal, see also http://www.regattanetwork.com/membermgmt29er/membership_registration_start.php

5 ADVERTISING

- 5.1 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

8.2 Scheduled Races: The Championship will be sailed with maximum 12 races.

8.3 At one day no more than 5 races will be sailed.

9 MEASUREMENTS

9.1 Hulls and sails must be in conformity with the Rules of the Class Associations.

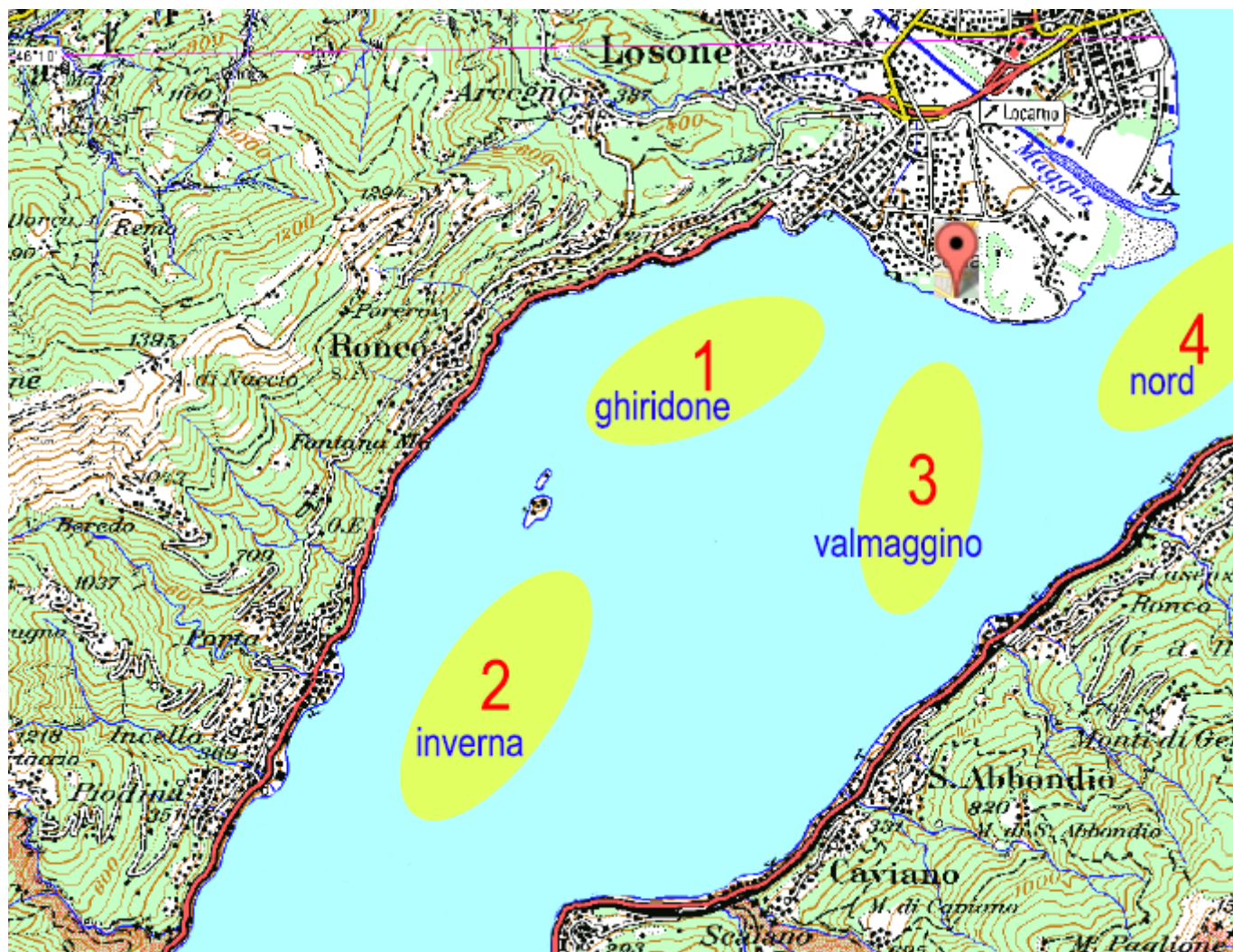
9.2 The Race Committee may check all boats and crews before, during and after the races.

10 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

10.1 The sailing instructions will be available at the registration office.

11 COURSES

11. The courses to be sailed will be windward-leeward courses. The race target time will be 30 minutes.



12 PENALTY SYSTEM

12.1 Rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

12.2 Decisions of the jury will be final as provided in rule 70.5.

13 SCORING

13.1 The low point scoring system of RRS Appendix A will apply.

13.2 Excluding worst scores: 1 worst score will be excluded after 4 valid races, 2 worst scores after 9 valid races.



14 SUPPORT BOATS

- 14.1 Support boats shall register via email (info@yclo.ch) not later than 15 Sep 2014.
- 14.2 The fee for support boats registration will be Euro 20 (to be paid at the registration office)
- 14.3 Support boats shall display their national letters on a flag or outboard covers.

15 PRIZES

- 15.1 Prizes will be given to first 5 places
- 15.2 Special prizes for top women's teams

16 RIGHTS TO USE NAMES & LIKENESSES

- 16.1 Competitors automatically grant to the organizing authority without payment the right in perpetuity to make, use and show any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or filmed television of or relating to the event.

17 LIABILITY AND INSURANCE

- 17.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk (See RRS rule 4 - Decision to race). The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
- 17.2 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with adequate cover per event and valid for racing.
